Did you know? Of the eight (8) known species of giant clams in the world, seven (7) are found in the Philippines. And one species, called "*taklobo*", can weigh more than 200 kilograms (440 lbs). It can measure as much as 120 cm (47 in) across and have an average lifespan in the wild of over 100 years and can be found off the coast of the Philippines.
